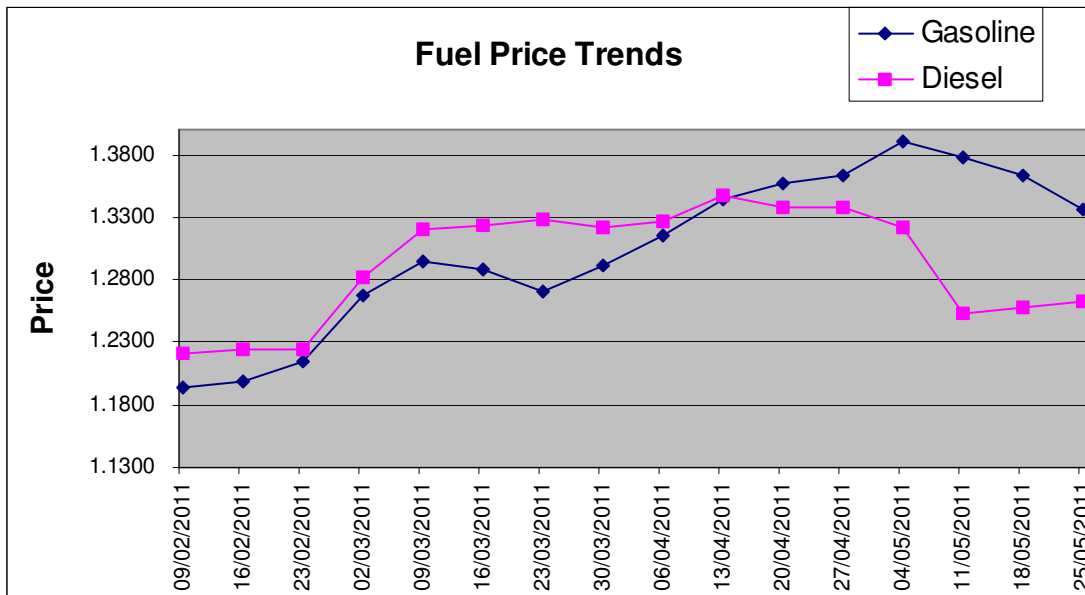

Price Trends

A news report that came out today (May 26) declared that BC has the second lowest Wholesale “Rack” prices in Canada, but also has the second **highest** Retail End User prices, lower than only Quebec. Sound strange? Well, it appears that taxes are the difference; only Quebec has a higher level of road taxation than BC. In BC, total taxes can add up to 35.4 cents per litre, including both Federal and Provincial taxes. Keep in mind that on July 1, our Carbon Tax increases another 1.1 cents for gasoline and 1.3 cents for Diesel.
